





GENERAL TRAINING

The IELTS Academic test is for those applying for tertiary education or professional registration in an English speaking country. It reflects some of the features of academic language and assesses whether you are ready to begin studying or training.


This approach is widely supported by many institutions that recognise IELTS.

The IELTS General Training test is for those who are migrating to English speaking countries for secondary education, work experience or training programs.

It is also a requirement for migration to most English speaking countries, including New Zealand. The test focuses on basic English skills in broad social and workplace contexts.

AEA TESOL

For pre-school or primary teachers with English as a second language.



AEA TESOL is an intensive 5-week course for non-native English speakers who wish to teach English to pre- and primary school aged children in their home country.

Entry Requirements:

- IELTS score of 5.5 overall or equivalent performance in the ICL Placement Test.
- · Police Check from your home country.

- How to engage young learners.
- · How to teach using songs, games and activities.

KIWIKINDY INTERNSHIP

Learn English and gain four weeks of work experience in a New Zealand kindergarten

Course Length:

Flexible (students can request the number of weeks they would like to participate in Kiwikindy)

Our Kiwikindy Internship Programme is part of the AEA TESOL Course. TESOL students get the opportunity to experience work in a New Zealand kindergarten. Students spend time in an Auckland-based kindergarten, where they interact with children, and see first hand how a Kiwi teacher conducts a class. The course length is flexible depending on the students.


